

# GOLF CART RULES

We are happy to be able to offer you the use of our golf cart! However, this privilege does come with some responsibilities, especially because it is **STREET LEGAL**. This means that it may be driven on any county road with a speed limit of 35 MPH or less. That makes it a great option for taking a ride down to the beach access or to Seaside to hang out!

Here are some guidelines to ensure that the cart is used appropriately and **LEGALLY!** 😊

1. Speed limits in the neighborhood must be strictly followed. The cart will travel at 25 mph but the speed limit is 15 mph in most of the neighborhood. We recommend a **speedometer app** for your phone to help you check your speed.
2. By Florida Statute, drivers must be at least 14 years old to operate a golf cart within NatureWalk. You are responsible for making sure any minor drivers are acting responsibly!
3. Only **licensed drivers** may operate the golf cart on county roads (like 395 and 30A) and **ONLY** where the speed limit is 35 mph (pretty much anywhere South of Naturewalk)
4. Golf carts may not be operated on sidewalks or on any trails in the state parks
5. Golf cart may be parked in regular parking spots as well as any designated golf cart parking.
6. Seat Belts must be worn at all times
7. The golf cart is equipped with lights and turn signals, as well as a horn. Please use these just as you would in a normal vehicle.
8. Please **DO NOT use the Windshield Wiper**. While this equipment is required by the state, it *will scratch the windshield*. If it is raining, please do not drive the golf cart.
9. **Charging:** You should not charge the golf cart unless the battery is at or below half a charge unless you are anticipating a long drive. Fully charged batteries should provide you with around 15 miles of range (not guaranteed) and recharging them too often can shorten their life span. Please charge only if needed and then **leave the cart charging when you check out**.
10. The **RENTER** is liable for damages or traffic citations occurring while operating the golf cart as well as **TOWING CHARGES** should it become stuck or stranded due to batteries being fully drained. Registration information can be found below the front passenger seat.
11. Please use the garden hose to rinse out the floorboard/rear step/etc if it gets sandy.

**PLEASE NOTE, THE GOLF CART BARELY FITS IN THE GARAGE!** When parking in the garage, you'll need to pull in as straight as possible and carefully ease to the very front of the garage. You may even need to lightly tap the wall in front of you with the tires to ensure the garage door will close. **WE APPRECIATE YOUR ATTENTION AND CARE WHEN PARKING!**
